

Printable Knitting Needle Gauge

Cut it out, keep it in your project bag — identify any needle or hook at a glance

PRINT CHECK — set your printer to 100% / Actual Size



This line must measure exactly 50 mm

A bank card must fit this box exactly

THE GAUGE — lay the needle shaft across the bar it matches exactly

Remember: old UK sizes run backwards — the bigger the number, the thinner the needle.

Always measure the straight shaft, never the tapered tip.
